Dear Customer,

We are pleased to have delivered our beautiful Wild Oak tabletops to you. To ensure that your tabletops remain in top condition and retain their natural beauty for many years, it is important to follow the maintenance guidelines below:

Cleaning:

- Use a soft, damp cloth to wipe the tabletop and remove dust and dirt.
- Avoid using harsh cleaning agents or abrasive sponges, as they can damage the lacquer surface and alter the appearance of the tabletop.

Protection against heat and moisture:

- Always use placemats or coasters under hot pots, plates, or cups to prevent heat damage or condensation rings.
- Wipe up any spills or liquids immediately to prevent stains or damage to the lacquer surface.
- If your home has underfloor heating, be aware that temperature changes and low humidity can affect the wood. To minimize the risk of drying out and cracking, it is recommended to maintain a humidity level of 40-60% in the room.

General Maintenance:

- Only the Bianco surface treatment contains lacquer, so no additional oil treatment is necessary.
- Oil, Smokey, Modern Grey, and Brownie are oil-treated and contain no lacquer.
- Avoid placing sharp objects directly on the table, as they may scratch the surface.

Long-Term Care:

- Be mindful of environmental factors such as direct sunlight and excessive humidity, as these can affect the condition and durability of the wood over time.
- Follow the above maintenance and cleaning instructions for your wooden tabletop.

By following these simple but important guidelines, you can enjoy your Wild Oak table for many years and maintain its natural beauty and durability.
